RECOMMENDATION:

That the Planning Commission's Capital Improvement Program Committee make a recommendation to the Planning Commission on priority projects for consideration by Town Council as part of their Fiscal Year 2024 (FY24) Capital budget review process.

BACKGROUND:

Staff facilitates meetings with the Planning Commission's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Committee annually regarding potential priority projects for the upcoming fiscal year. The Planning Commission's CIP Committee makes recommendations to the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission's recommendations are provided to Town Council prior to their budget deliberations, which are tentatively scheduled to occur in May 2023.

SUMMARY:

The State's enabling legislation assigns the Planning Commission the duty to prepare "an annual listing of priority projects for consideration by the Town Council prior to their preparation of the capital budget." A list of proposed priority projects for FY24 has been prepared for consideration based on the status of FY23 projects, projects on the most recent recommended priority list from Planning Commission, and the input of the Parks and Recreation Commission (PRC), Bike Walk HHI, and staff.
