SUBJECT: Budget Workshop of May 11th

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Town Council hear presentations from the Town Manager on his recommended Fiscal 2024 Budget. Town Council will have an opportunity to review and discuss the proposal.

BACKGROUND:

The Town Code directs the Town Manager to propose a budget to the Town Council each year. The Town Manager has proposed a budget on May 2, 2023, for Fiscal Year 2024. Town Council will have a chance to review and discuss the proposed budget in two public workshops – one on May 9th and one on May 11th.

Town Council voted on May 2nd to approve first reading of proposed ordinance 2023-10 adopting the Municipal Budget for the Town of Hilton Head Island Fiscal Year 2024 ending June 30, 2024. The motion was passed with a vote of 6-1 (Becker opposed).

SUMMARY:

The May 11th workshop will focus on the proposed budget for the Capital Improvements Plan, but could include General, Debt Service, Stormwater, Gullah Geechee Historical Neighborhood Community Development Corporation, and Housing Funds.
