**2. Freedom of Information Act Compliance**

**3. Approval of Minutes**

**a. Regular Public Safety Committee Meeting of June 2, 2014**

A motion to approve the minutes of the June 2, 2014 meeting of the Public Safety Committee was made by Mr. Harkins and seconded by Mr. McCann. The motion was approved by a vote of 3-0.

**4. Unfinished Business**

**5. New Business**

**a. Consideration of a Request to Amend the Beaufort County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Contract Dated January 17, 2012. Review of BCSO Traffic Tickets and Warnings and S.C. Highway Patrol Traffic Enforcement, and Other Data Presented by BCSO.**

Brian Hulbert, Staff Attorney, reminded the Committee that at a recent Budget Workshop the Council had discussed with Sheriff Tanner the possibility of removing the 4-member traffic team requirement from the BCSO contract to allow those officers to be assigned as needed by the Sheriff's Office in lieu of the Sheriff's request for a 3-member special unit. Town Council was

presented with a proposed contract amendment, and a motion was made to send the request to the Public Safety Committee to determine whether this was in the Town's best interests.

Capt. Joey Woodward, Beaufort County Sheriff's Office, addressed questions from the Committee about the use of the 4-member traffic team designated under the current contract. He noted their primary function is traffic control, including working wrecks, keeping traffic flowing on US 278, and anything traffic related, and there are times when they are used in emergencies as needed. Mr. Hulbert noted one difference being proposed is that the current traffic team shift of 7 AM to 7 PM would change, so they could be utilized when the criminal activity is highest in certain areas. He explained this would supplant the overtime currently being paid for the bar patrol, with flexible hours assigned to augment the forces on the Island at night when crimes are occurring.

Mr. McCann expressed concern about traffic control and traffic ticketing if the traffic team is reassigned for other functions. Capt. Woodward assured the Committee that all the officers assigned to the Southern Division would still write tickets.

Sheriff P.J. Tanner, Beaufort County Sheriff's Office, confirmed for Chairman Grant and the Committee that the deputy sheriffs would continue to conduct traffic control and ticketing, including the 4 that would be assigned to work from 7 PM to 3 AM when the calls for service are the highest during the summer. He noted there are deputy sheriffs working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week on Hilton Head Island, with all of them involved in traffic enforcement.

Sheriff Tanner assured Mr. Harkins and Chairman Grant that there should be no negative impact on traffic enforcement or responses to traffic accidents. He explained the need to use all the assets assigned to Hilton Head Island and deploy those resources appropriately based on calls for service, which would require an amendment to the existing contract, which he supported. He noted the alternative would be the need for a budget increase of \$435,000 for a 4-person special enforcement unit. Sheriff Tanner assured the Committee that between the BCSO and the Highway Patrol, traffic is handled on Hilton Head Island and Beaufort County in totality.

Sheriff Tanner discussed briefly the need at some point in time to add additional deputies to Hilton Head Island due to the increase in population, the numbers of tourists, and the higher number of calls for service. Sheriff Tanner noted that outside of a budget increase, the amendment in the contract allowing the deployment of resources as needed based on calls for service is the appropriate way to proceed, and this will cause no harm to law enforcement on Hilton Head Island.

Mr. Hulbert pointed out there is a 3-year contract with the Town that expires in January, so this discussion about deployment may also come up in December before renewal of the contract in January of 2015.

Greg DeLoach, Assistant Town Manager, noted that the Committee had also requested information about the Highway Patrol presence on Hilton Head Island, and the Sheriff's Office had invited a representative to attend today's meeting.

1<sup>st</sup> Sgt. Dennis Boniecki, Post Commander for the Highway Patrol, who is in charge of Beaufort and Jasper Counties, assured the Committee that there is frequently a highway patrol officer on the Island during the course of the day enforcing traffic. 1<sup>st</sup> Sgt. Boniecki indicated there was no set time schedule, but noted their presence predominantly at night, particularly late on Fridays and Saturdays, and early morning enforcement of the seat belt law. He advised there are 2 troopers who live on the Island, and take their cars home with them.

Chairman Grant thanked 1<sup>st</sup> Sgt. Boniecki for his comments and asked for public comments, but there were none.

A motion was made by Mr. Harkins that the Committee recommend to Town Council that that the Beaufort County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) Contract Dated January 17, 2012, be amended to remove the requirement for BCSO to provide a four member traffic enforcement team as discussed by Town Council. Mr. McCann seconded the motion, and the motion was approved by a vote of 3-0.

## 6. Adjournment

At 10:21 a.m. Mr. Harkins moved to adjourn the meeting and Mr. McCann seconded. The motion was approved by a vote of 3-0.

## **DATA SOURCE/CRITERIA**

All law enforcement agencies in the state compile incident-based data on crimes occurring in their jurisdiction. While one incident can result in multiple offenses being tracked in the local system, only data that meets the national criteria is forwarded to the SC Law Enforcement Division.

Currently if a burglary is reported and property stolen, two offenses are tracked locally but only the major crime, burglary, is reported using the South Carolina Incident-Based Reporting System. This data is collected by SLED and then forwarded to the FBI, which administers the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program.

The Beaufort County Sheriff's Office will begin using the UCR criteria to account for crime in this report so that it will more closely match the data published by the FBI.


Crimes Against Persons will include Murder, Aggravated Assault, Robbery and Forcible Rape.

Crimes Against Property will include Burglary, Larceny and Auto Theft.  
Vehicle Collisions will remain the same as they are not reportable UCR crimes.

This report is based only on the crimes that occurred on Hilton Head Island.

These statistics are compiled using the following Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) criteria:

**Murder and non-negligent manslaughter:** The willful killing of one human being by another. Any death due to injuries received in a fight, quarrel, assault or commission of a crime is classified in this category.

**Aggravated Assault:** An unlawful attack by one person upon another wherein the offender uses a weapon or displays it in a threatening manner, or the victim suffers obvious severe or aggravated bodily injury (involving apparent broken bones, loss of teeth, possibly internal injury, severe laceration, loss of consciousness due to injury, etc.)

**Robbery:** Taking or attempting to take, under confrontational circumstances, anything of value from another person by force or threat of force or violence and/or by putting the victim in fear of immediate harm.

**Forcible Rape:** Any sexual act directed against another person, forcibly and/or against the persons will; or not forcibly or against the person's will where the person is unable to give consent. A person may unable to give consent due to: very young or very old, mental or physical incapacity, intoxication, the influence of drugs.



## CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY



**Burglary/Breaking & Entering:** The UNLAWFUL ENTRY into a building or other structure with the intent to commit a serious crime or theft.

**Structure:** A structure is defined as a building or walled enclosure which can be enclosed on all sides by closing doors or windows.

Motor vehicles, motor homes, trailers and other mobile property are NOT structures. Some mobile property may be made immobile.

**Larceny:** The unlawful taking of property from the possession or constructive possession of another person. Types of larceny include: pocket picking, purse snatching, shoplifting, theft from a building theft from coin operated machine or device, theft from a motor vehicle, theft of motor vehicle parts and thefts from enclosures, etc, and from residences where no unlawful entry of a structure is involved.

**Motor Vehicle Theft:** Theft of a motor vehicle. This does not include using a motor vehicle without the expressed consent of the owner.


