- Chairman Gant called the Circle to Circle Committee meeting to order at 10:34 a.m.
- The meeting agenda and minutes from the July 15, 2015 were approved.
- Chairman Gant introduced the only agenda item of old business: Area Vision Discussion.
- Chairman Gant continued discussions on the cornerstones that were identified at the last meeting by the Committee to guide the development of the vision for the area. Following the meeting Chairman Gant summarized the Committee's input into four principles: 1) Convey a "sense of place" and character for the C2C area (and may extend to the bridge), 2) Preserve and enhance the natural environment - lush tropical landscape, 3) Provide an island experience and 4) Balance the needs and wants of residents with those of tourists/future residents.
- Following the last meeting, Committee Member David Ames suggested that in order to assist with the development of a combined vision, Committee Members should write a few paragraphs to tell the story of what they see in their minds' eyes ten years from now for the Circle to Circle Area to create a picture with words that will help identify attributes of the vision. Chairman Gant presented each of the summaries that were submitted and the Committee highlighted words that stood out to them.
- Chairman Gant informed the committee that he would update the draft cornerstones based on this input and will present it at the 4 o'clock public feedback session that was scheduled to be the follow-up the May Community Forums to gain public feedback on the work of the Committee.
- Following public comments, he adjourned the meeting at 10:20 a.m.
