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**I Call to Order:**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M.

Mr. Soule noted the Gullah Celebration which is conducted by the Native Island Business and Community Association is held in February each year and they would have to have their funding in place a year in advance. Mr. Soule moved to amend the motion to include an exception and recommend that Town Council continue forward funding for the Native Island

Business and Community Association due to the timing of the Gullah Celebration. Mr. Keskin seconded the motion. The amended motion passed unanimously. (6-0)
