1. SC-4 SWEEPING REQUIREMENTS of the Special Conditions has been modified:

The Contractor shall sweep all required streets identified in Exhibits C and D with a high power vacuum street sweeper. The areas to be swept include all areas of curb, curb and gutter, inverted crown, and inverted gutters found on those roadways. ~~from the top of the curb on one side of the street to the top of the curb on the other side of the street, or from edge of asphalt on one side of the street to the edge of asphalt on the other side of the street, whichever is applicable.~~ All streets and work areas identified in Exhibits C and D shall be cleaned once per week, at a minimum, unless otherwise authorized by the Town.

~~Street sweeping shall include all asphalt, intersections, median cuts, and concrete islands within the specified areas. Additionally, this shall include a minimum of 30 feet from the edge of the intersection down the cross street.~~

The cleaning operation does not include removal of debris and waste materials from within catch basins, grate inlets or storm sewers but does require removal of all debris located on the grate inlet or in front of a catch basin which may impede flow of surface runoff.

The Contractor shall hand remove and hand sweep all debris in all specified areas that is not vacuumed up by the street sweeper. This removal shall occur during daylight hours in accordance with the specified safety requirements.

The Contractor shall be responsible for the proper disposal of all debris at Contractor's expense.

2. SC-11 PERMISSIBLE WORK DAYS AND HOURS of the Special Conditions has been modified:

~~Daytime cleaning operations shall be performed between the hours of 4:00 AM and 8:00 AM on Monday through Friday. Nighttime cleaning operations shall be~~

~~performed between the hours of 12:00 AM and 5:00 AM, Sunday night through Saturday morning.~~ The Contractor shall schedule and perform all cleaning operations between the hours of 12:00 AM and 7:00 AM Sunday-Saturday. Work outside of these times is prohibited without the prior written consent of the Town.

The Contractor will be expected to complete all of the work assigned under this contract without any stoppages other than those necessitated by weather and equipment failures.

3. SC-13 SCHEDULING of the Special Conditions has been modified:

Prior to commencement of work, the Contractor shall propose the schedule by which he plans to do the work ~~with~~ within the specified time periods ~~for each location~~ identified in ~~Exhibit D~~ SC-11 PERMISSIBLE WORK DAYS AND HOURS. No work shall begin until the Town provides written approval of the proposed schedule. Any variation in the approved schedule will require written approval by the Town. Please be advised that all work shall be completed no later than ~~5:00 AM~~ 7:00 AM.

4. UNIT PRICE SCHEDULE was modified to ADD the following line items:

5. EXHIBIT D has been modified and included in this Addendum.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS - The following are questions received by the Town prior to the advertised deadline, with corresponding answers.

1. Are there any noise restrictions?

Answer: No. Per the Noise Control chapter of the Town’s Municipal Code, this work is covered under Sec. 17-4-115 - Exceptions:

1. Sound produced by a vehicle (not including sound produced by an emitter with any such vehicle) while vehicle is moving on a public right-of-way or public waterway, or is otherwise being lawfully operated;
2. Sound produced by a governmental body in the performance of a governmental function

2. What is the frequency for sweeping a specific area? Every other week?

Answer: See modifications to SC-4 above.

3. The medians are not included in sweeping unless they have curbs and stormwater drains or catch basins; like on the Cross Island Bridge. Please confirm.

Answer: See modifications to SC-4 above. The only median included in Exhibit C is the median on Palmetto Bay Road from Genesta to the Cross Island Bridge.

4. Catch basins that are recessed and cannot be swept by machine must still be cleaned. The operator must exist vehicle to clean out by hand (or other equipment). Please confirm.

Answer: Correct.

5. Are all curbs and gutters on the sides of the road included, regardless if there is a stormwater drain there or not? Many curbs are completely solid and perform no drain function (pic 1 below).. Others have breaks to allow water to escape but the water does not enter the storm water sewage system (pic 2 below).

Answer: See modifications to SC-4 above.

6. Roads that have no curbs at all, simply 24” catch basins in the middle of the road, the function will be to simply clean the drain catch basin (pic 3 below.)

Answer: See modifications to SC-4 above. Catch basins within the centerline of the inverted crown roadway need to be swept.
