- The Development Team will review our Draft Goals during their meeting on Monday, October 7, 2019 from 4:00 to 5:30 PM. The meeting will be in Council Chambers. The Work Group is encouraged to attend.
- Wrote draft goals:
  1. Reduce the amount of solid waste. (A reduction of 50% or more.)
  2. Develop and publicize a new eco-friendly Hilton Head Island brand as leaders in environmental protection and sustainability.
  3. Maximize the efficiency of water usage. (To include potable and runoff.)
  4. Protect and restore the natural infrastructure of Hilton Head Island. (Natural infrastructure includes marshes, turtles, trees, etc.)
  5. Maximize the efficiency of energy usage and expand the use of renewable energy.
  6. Ensure adequate protection for human health and the environment. (Through development and redevelopment standards.)
  7. Develop strategies to address climate change.
  8. Improve air quality by reducing/minimizing emissions.
