### 1. PAPP-002073-2023 - Proposed Rezoning Map Amendment of 870 William Hilton Parkway

Glenn Maddux of Middle Street Partners, LLC. is proposing to amend the Official Zoning Map by changing the zoning designation of a developed 5.21-acre parcel located at 870 William Hilton Parkway. The Property is zoned Light Commercial and is part of the Long Cove Club Master Plan. The property is assigned the following Beaufort County tax map parcel identification number: R550 011 000 138B 0000. The request is to rezone the property from LC (Light Commercial District) to PD-1 (Planned Development Mixed-Use). The effect of this rezoning will be to allow residential multifamily use on the parcel with an allowable density for 136 residential apartments.
