As part of our ongoing commitment to preserving this natural resource, the Town of Hilton Head Island is undertaking the 2025-2026 Beach Renourishment Project. **Our beaches will remain open** throughout the project for residents and visitors to enjoy.

WHY

- Protects and preserves our shorelines.
- Provides wide, sandy beaches for our residents and visitors to enjoy.
- Demonstrates a proactive commitment to coastal protection.
- Upholds our responsibility to our Island, residents, visitors and wildlife.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Continuous 24/7 activity.
- Beach-compatible sand is delivered offshore to the beach.
- Offshore hydraulic dredging operations.
- Relocation of two million cubic yards.
- Temporary beach access restrictions in work zones.
- Daily reshaping of approximately 300 feet of shoreline.

PHASE 1 -
The Heel/Port Royal, Fish Haul, and Pine Island
Contractor mobilizes in July 2025
Work begins August 2025



PHASE 2 -
Central Island, South Island, and
South Beach
Work begins November 2025



PHASE 3 -
Pine Island Structures
TBD in 2026
