Dear Members,

The Sandbox Children's Museum is committed to being here to support you and meet the needs of you and your child(ren) throughout these challenging times. To support families with children in grades K-4 enrolled in the BCSD, we are offering a museum school program. In small multi-age learning pods, children will have daily support for their virtual lessons in addition to enrichment in S.T.E.A.M., literacy, movement, and time for free play in the museum. Children will be grouped K-1, 2-4 with no more than 10 children per group with a maximum of children at the Hilton Head location of 15 and Tanger 2 location of 20. Children enrolled will have exclusive access to the museum during the weekdays.

With strict health and safety guidelines we will provide a school setting with supplemental hands-on learning and discovery through cool science (S.T.E.M.), literacy, art, movement, and music, on all BCSD school days from 8:15am – 3:15 pm.

**Fees:** Members who register prior to August 17<sup>th</sup> = **\$187.50/wk** paid monthly(\$750) in advance. \$375.00 is due with registration and \$375 due by September 4<sup>th</sup>. All registration forms and waiver must be submitted prior to acceptance.

**Registrations received after August 17<sup>th</sup> the fee is \$198.75/wk** with \$397.50 due with registration. Families must commit to enrollment for the Fall semester and full payment of fees with no refunds for absences or illness.

The Sandbox will provide:

- Dedicated learning space with Internet access.
- Supervision of virtual learning with active support from on-site learning coach with education experience.
- Support and communication for parents during the semester.
- Individual supplies (scissors, glue sticks, colored pencils, pencils, markers) and cubby space for each child.

- Enrichment activities developed by specialists in that field.
- Art and science supplies need for enrichment activities.

The daily schedule will follow your child's virtual schedule but allow time for snack, lunch with the pod and enrichment time. All children will have access to art and movement several times a week.

Attached is the registration form, waiver, and policies. To enroll please complete the forms and either mail back, email & call with deposit information, or drop off at either location during play session hours. Please make sure if you drop off paperwork that you hand it to a staff member. You will receive a confirmation email of your enrollment once the paperwork has been processed.
