## An Update from Assistant Town Manager Josh Gruber 6/26/2020

Good afternoon Hilton Head Islanders and Guests,

With the continued rise in coronavirus cases across South Carolina, our Town Council will be considering an ordinance to take a tougher stance on wearing masks in public. Mayor John McCann has called for a virtual special Town Council meeting at 8:30 a.m. Monday, June 29, for discussion of an ordinance requiring the wearing of face masks in certain areas. Municipalities across the state and country have adopted laws for wearing masks as a way to protect their residents and help curb the upward trend of coronavirus cases. With concerns the public has brought to the Town's attention, Mayor McCann feels it's time to address this. Our staff researched similar laws and drafted an ordinance that will be presented to Town Council for consideration.

### **COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Event on June 29th**

As we continue to tackle the COVID-19 pandemic, we are giving community residents an opportunity to be tested for the coronavirus. Our Hilton Head Island Fire Rescue, along with Hilton Head Hospital, the Volunteers In Medicine Clinic and SCDHEC, is hosting a COVID-19 Drive-Thru Testing Event on Monday, June 29<sup>th</sup>, from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Hilton Head Island High School, 70 Wilborn Road.

- Anyone can participate.
- The test is free.
- No appointment is required.
- No doctor's order is required.
- This is only a test for the virus.
- This is not a test for COVID-19 antibodies.
- This will be a nasal swab.
- This is not a rapid test. Results are expected to be returned in 2 to 4 days.

- You will receive phone call with test results.
- There are no prerequisites for the test such as having symptoms.
- Multiple persons within a vehicle may be tested.
- We ask your patience as traffic flow may be heavy in the area.

SCDHEC partners with organizations around the Lowcountry to host mobile pop-up clinics, where you may receive a free screening for the coronavirus.
